

**Resources management in farms** 

The project developed a set of tools (InnoTools) and services (InnoScorecard and InnoRegion) for improving SMEs opportunities, capacities, and knowledge in introducing product and process innovations.

Resources management in farms

The project promotes technology to enhance the wide implementation of sustainable management strategies at farm level in terms of resources management and reduction of carbon, waste, and water footprint of Balkan agricultural products.

**Protection of wetlands** 

The project developed a common knowledge basis including mapping and creation of harmonized geospatial datasets and indicators, a database, and pilot studies on conservation techniques.

Activities were developed to support the uptake of the common knowledge basis including creation of guidance, training workshops, continuous interaction with users and stakeholders, and publications for translating project findings into policy and priority actions.
